### Nordic News

The Lewis Ski Club presently has four local Nordic outings for the upcoming season, as well as a 5 night stay in Quebec Canada. The first two are at Chapin Forest, on January 15 and 29. Chapin is an excellent location to learn Nordic skiing, and it is within an hour drive from NASA GRC. Pine Lodge houses the ski rentals, hot/cold refreshments and the ski school operation. Both dates are on Saturday, with the Nordic Flurry race taking place on the morning of the 29<sup>th</sup>. Contact Linda Elonen-Wright for more details about this event.

The Quebec City Canada trip leaves on February 6, 2005. They have the largest cross-country center in all of Canada, and we will be there for 4 days. This includes a diversified network of 224 km of groomed trails, with 7 heated shelters. The main lodge has a rental & repair shop, and self-help waxing room. If this weren't enough, we will be in Quebec City during the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Winter Carnival. This is the largest of its type in the world, and includes international snow sculptures, dogsled rides, horse-drawn sleigh

rides, etc. See the attached Flyer in the September Newsletter for more details. Contact Gloria O'Donnell, or myself to sign up for this trip. We originally reserved 30 spaces for this trip, but sign-ups have slowed. Beware that we may reduce the number of remaining spaces for this trip!! Prices and availability could change significantly in December, so sign-up ASAP if you intend to go.


