As we gathered at the mouth of the river and Wendy checked out the conditions on Lake Erie. We paddled back into the mouth of the river, riding the waves, where we gathered once again before going down the west channel of the Rocky River, on the west side of the Cleveland Yacht Club. Victoria had planned ahead and invited us all to her dockside where we passed out ice cream sandwiches she had stashed in a cooler on her little dock. We then headed back to the boat launching ramps, where we had started the evening. After disembarking and helping to put away the kayaking gear and changing into dry clothing, many of us went to Around The Corner for some refreshments to top off a fun evening.

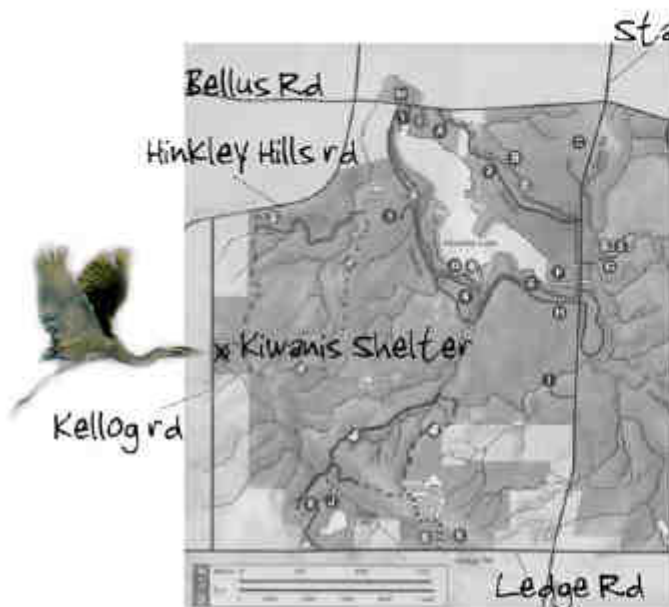

There is not a better way to spend a hot summer day than on the river! The Lower Yough (pronounced "Yok") is as refreshing as it is fun. The scenery is beautiful as the river runs through the protected wilderness of Ohioypyle State Park.

You'll begin your day at Wilderness Voyageurs' Outfitter Store where you'll check in, receive your life jacket & helmet and meet a couple of your River Guides. From there you'll be transported to the staging area where you'll begin your river trip.

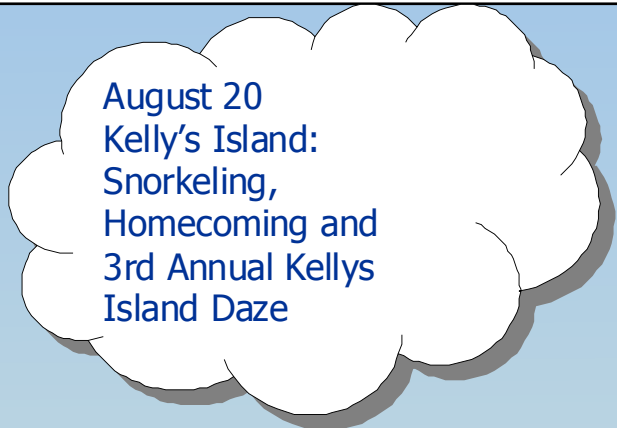
