Nordic News

Ski Season is here! We presently have scheduled two Nordic outings to Chapin Forest on Jan 15 and 29. Chapin Forest has excellent Nordic facilities, and is particularly well suited for beginners due to the availability of rental equipment and lessons. There is no Alpine ski event scheduled for the weekend of January 15, so come visit the wooded scenery at Chapin. Take I-90 to Rt. 306 south for 3.5 miles to Chardon Road (Rt 6) and turn right (west) for one mile to Hobart Road. Turn right (north) for almost 1/2 mile to the park entrance, located on the right (east) side of the road. Meet at Pine Lodge at 11:00 am. See the Chapin Flyer at the end of the newsletter for additional information. I will be at the NASA DEB parking lot at 9:45 am on Jan 15 for those who wish to Car Pool. Maps to Chapin will be available there.

We return to Chapin on January 29 to observe the "Arctic Flurry" Nordic Race at 8:00 am. Chapin will remain open for recreational skiing during the race, so come and cheer for Linda in her bid to be Ohio Nordic Champion! Last year's race day was quite a festival. There was an outdoor cookout, DJ spinning musical tunes, and snow sculptures near the Pine Lodge facility. Call Linda Elonen-Wright at (216)433-9370 (work) for more information on this event.

There are ONLY 7 SPACES REMAINING on the Quebec City trip! You must call by January 4th before all unsold spaces are eliminated. The Quebec City Canada trip promises to be one of the most diversified and unique travel opportunities of the year. Old Quebec will soon be celebrating its 400th anniversary, making it one of the most historic sites in North America. There are many restored fortifications, museums, and shopping malls only a short distance from our hotel. The trip leaves on February 6, and returns on February 11, 2005. They have the largest crosscountry center in all of Canada, and we will stay there 4 full days. This includes a diversified network of 224 km of groomed trails, with 7 heated shelters. The main lodge has a rental & repair shop, and self-help waxing room. If this weren't enough, we will be in Quebec City during the 50th Anniversary Winter Carnival. This is the largest of its type in the world, and includes international snow sculptures, dogsled rides, horse-drawn sleigh rides, etc. See the attached Flyer in the December Newsletter for more details.
