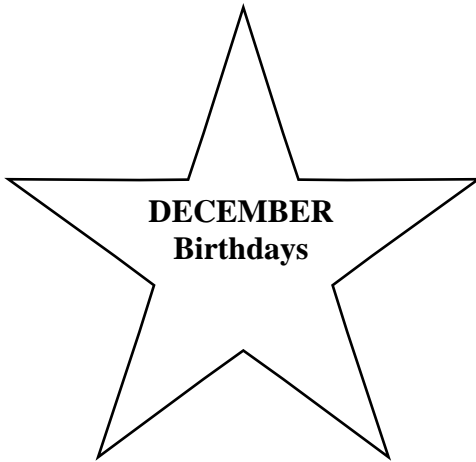

Nordic News

We've had a first hint of snow now and I'm sure we're all looking forward to the ski season. The Nordic Flurry race will be held Sunday, January 27, 2008 at Chapin Forest. There will be a 5K classic race and a 10K race where the racer can choose either skate or classic.

Chapin Forest is the hub of local XC ski activity. Keep the ski conditions hot line number handy: (440) 954- 4178. During ski season this number reaches a recording giving the day's snow conditions for both Chapin and Girdled Road reservations.

Cross Country Skier magazine has a web site (<http://www.crosscountryskier.com/>) with some of the print articles appearing there. I like the Technique and Training section (<http://www.crosscountryskier.com/training.htm>) ; there's something there for all levels.

In the November newsletter, in the report on the hike at Ledges and Boston Run, someone commented that Boston Run looks like a possible cross country ski trail. It is! I've skied it many times. There are several drainages across the path so you need good snow cover (and consistent cold temperatures) for it to be good skiing. Other trails in the Cuyahoga Valley National Park are also suitable for skiing, including Tree Farm Trail (at Horseshoe Pond), the Cross Country Trail by Kendall Lake (can be muddy), and Plateau Trail when there's good snow coverage (some of the trail base is rocky).

Don't forget the Ski Denton trip on February 19. I'll put complete details in the January newsletter.

Alpine Racing Update - Going Downhill Fast

Hope everybody is ready for the ski season, it's really just around the corner. Literally. Many New England resorts are off to a great start, with good early season skiing available right now! Here's an update on the race season just ahead.

The CMSC Race Committee held their preseason meeting with the ski club race chairs at Reineckers Party Center on Nov. 19. Changes and plans for this years racing program were highlighted by the committee, chaired this year by Frank Houdak and Bootsie Ricketts.

NASA Lewis has 10 registered racers for the 2008 Season. Hope to many of you on the hill, early and often this season.

Weekend and Wednesday night race schedules are finalized, and available on the CMSC website: www.skicleveland.com

Qualifier is set for Wednesday, Jan. 2, 2007 at Boston Mills. Registration is onsite in the Teachers Loft, \$9, from 6 to 7pm. Start time is 7:30pm, in bib order.

Geiger's is sponsoring a Rookie Racer Challenge this year. Qualifiers on Jan. 2 will be entered in a drawing for a \$50 gift certificate that night. At each race weekend, qualifiers at each race will be entered in a drawing for a \$25 gift certificate, to be awarded that day. Each race a new qualifier attends during the season will earn them a chance for a season end grand prize of a \$500 gift certificate. The more races they attend, the more chances they have to win. Grand prize will be awarded at the race banquet on April 12th. Save that date, it will be an out of this world good time, with the party adopting an "Aliens" theme this year.

The Groups and classes have been modified for the weekend series. There is no Group 4 (C classes) in skiing. CVM, CVW, CM, and CW have been combined with their respective CC classes in Group 3. Snowboarders now run as Group 4. BVW was also eliminated, and racers in that class were given the choice of moving to BW or AVW. The only NASA racers affected by these changes are Paul Senick, who is now in CCM, and Barb Cool, who decided to run in AVW. Good luck to both, and the rest of our team.

There will be an Exhibition Class for this season, called Super Senior Vet, which will run at the front of Group 1. This coed class is for age 70 and over, competitive (Class B or better) former racers who want to try racing again. There are no prizes, points, or trophies for this class. Senior Vet remains as a coed class for age 55 and over competitors who never raced higher than CC, with full points, prizes, and trophy eligibility.

The race committee is interested in suggestions for the beneficiary of the annual charity race at Boston Mills. They prefer a local charity or organization in NE Ohio.

First race of the year is at Holiday Valley on Jan 5 and 6, followed by Kissing Bridge on Jan 12, Bristol Mountain on Jan. 19 and 20, Peek-n-Peak on Jan.26, and a return to the Legend, Cockaigne on Jan. 27.

Just a reminder of the special learn to ski and snowboard day at Boston Mills on December 16, flyers are available on the CMSC website.

The race team is again selling candy, cookies and snacks in Buildings 77, 6, and 86, to help defray the cost of registration fees. We've already earned enough to cover the first half of the fees for the year, and should be able to cover the whole season once again, so all you need is your lift ticket to go racing with us. Here's to a great season, and hope to see many new faces and familiar ones on the race hill this year.
