Fall Hike: (Viaduct Park Bedford) Sun. Nov. 9th @ 3pm. Our hike for November will be a rather short hike, but full of history and 19th century innovation. We will start out at the Bedford Historical Society Museum at 3pm on Sunday Nov. 9th, with stops at Viaduct Park, Bedford Falls and a trip thru a mill race.

All told the hike should cover about 2.5 miles (mostly on pavement) and take about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours. We should be at peak fall colors. The Bedford Historical Society Museum (free) is



open with 3 floors of exhibits. We'll spend about an hour at the museum and then start our hike from there. There will be a little surprise which will include the need for a few flashlights (so bring a flashlight).

The Bedford Historical Society Museum is located on Broadway at the south side of Bedford's town square / park (southern side of downtown Bedford). There is parking either on Broadway next to and on the backside of the Square with more parking next to the train depot.
