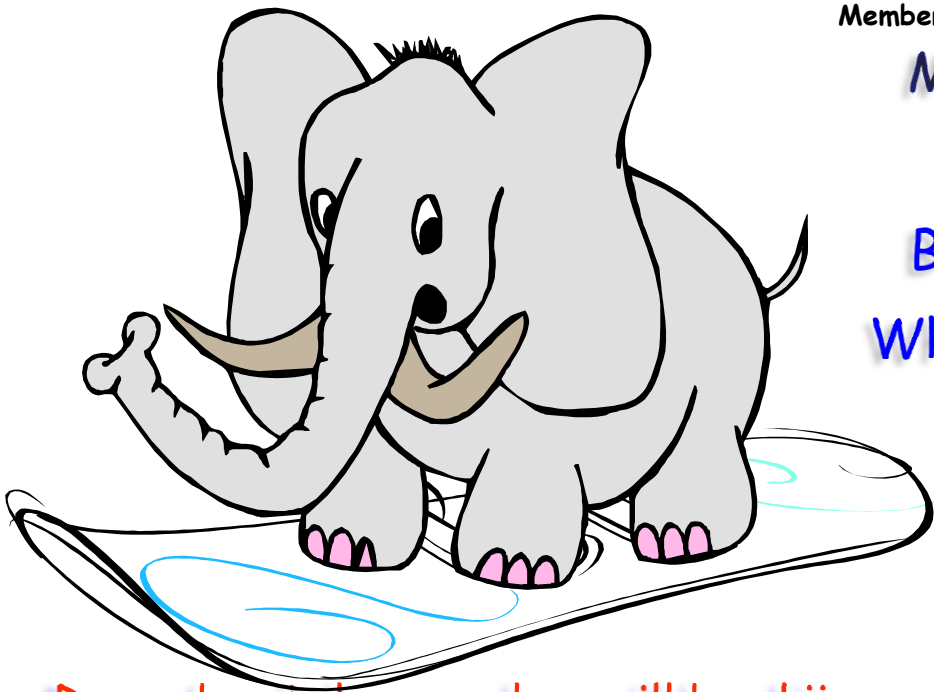

December is here and we will be skiing and boarding soon. Make sure that your equipment and you are ready to hit the slopes.

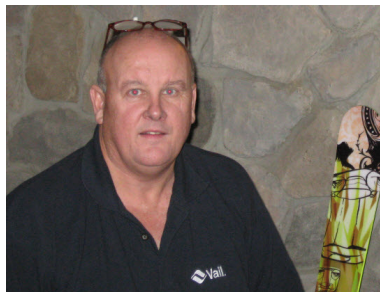

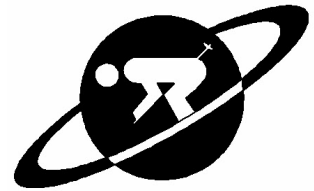
