Remembering Annie Easley

The Lewis Ski Club reports with great sadness the loss of Annie Easley on June 25 at the age of 79. Annie was a founding member of the NASA Lewis Ski Club. She will be remembered and clearly missed.

Along with her involvement with this club, she was also involved with CMSC, Fagowees, Snowballers, Erie Shore Ski Club and Warren Ski Club.

Annie, a native of Birmingham, Ala. was a longtime NASA employee and started in 1954 when the agency was still known as NACA. She worked in the



Launch Vehicles Division and co-authored many papers. An obituary can be found on the Plain Dealer's website. Members of this club and numerous others have shared their memories on our website and on her guestbook:

"Annie was also one of those rare people who lived a full life and spread happiness, laughter, and her opinion to everyone she met. What a great inspiration she has been to me over these past 25 years-and to so many others. She started skiing in her mid 40's and snow boarding at 70 years old! She was a founding member of the NASA Lewis Ski Club and she actively served the club since the 1970's and after her retirement, including as President, trustee, trip coordinator, etc. She was also involved in the Cleveland skiing scene, serving as President of the Cleveland Metro Ski Club, and she was a member of other Cleveland area ski clubs as well. She was an active golfer and a successful real estate agent after she retired from NASA Lewis. She lived an amazing life, and this message does not even begin to capture who she was and how she positively impacted so many of us."

"Annie embodied the spirit of hospitality for Lewis Ski Club. She was a wonderful greeter, connector, and encourager. I had only a 3 year acquaintance, which was enough to value all she did for skiers, who quickly became more like new family members than casual acquaintances."

"Annie will be missed and thought of every time NASA ski club goes on a trip. What a fun loving lady, who enjoyed every moment. She personified "CARPE DIEM" (seize the day)."

"Annie personified the spirit of friendship to me and everyone she associated. She was an inspiration to get up and go and enjoy the ride with her fellow travelers to it's fullest. She is surely a welcome angel to His realm."

The undersigned participant applies to participate in the Lewis Ski Club trip described below, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. DEPOSIT: The required initial deposit for this trip must be paid and submitted along with a signed Trip Application and Agreement. Balance shall be due and payable in accordance with payment schedules established by Lewis Ski Club.

2. WITHDRAWAL & CHANGE: Lewis Ski Club may withdraw any trip from its schedule at any time; may refuse to accept or retain any person as a participant at any time for any reason; and may change the itinerary at any time.
3. RESPONSIBILITY: Lewis Ski Club is acting gratuitously for the applicant and shall not be responsible or liable for any loss of damage to baggage, property, or for any loss, injury, death, accident, delay, inconvenience or any other loss occurring during or occasioned by applicant's participation or lack of participation in any trip. Trip participants ski and/or snowboard at their own risk. It is the injured skier's/snowboarder's responsibility to report to Ski Patrol for treatment or referral to hospital/doctor. If unable to accompany the club on return trip as planned, the injured party is responsible for arranging their own transportation for the return trip.
