



LEWIS SKI CLUB – PROPOSED CONSTITUTION CHANGES (4-3-2012)

ARTICLE IV: GOVERNMENT; Section 11: Meetings

From: Executive Board meetings will take place on the next to last Tuesday of every month. A combined meeting of the newly elected officers and the current officers will be held on the next-to-last Thursday in April. All Executive Board meetings will be open to all members. To: An Executive Board meeting shall be called by the President at least once a month, usually the next to last Tuesday of the month. The Executive Board meeting called for in the month of April will be a combined meeting of the newly elected officers and the current officers. All Executive Board meetings will be open to all members.

ARTICLE IV: GOVERNMENT; Section 13: Spending Policy

From: All non-recoverable expenditures shall require the following approvals prior to the expenditure: \$0.00 through \$100.00 – approval of at least two members of the Executive Board; \$100.01-\$200.00 – approval of the Executive Board; anything above \$200.00 – approval of simple majority of the members present at a regular scheduled meeting (quorum required). Add: (i) Recruitment Chairperson – coordinates efforts targeted directly at the recruitment of new members.

Add: (j) Historian – responsible for maintaining the history of the club.
