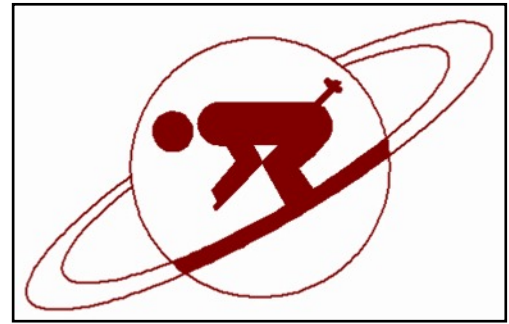

## **How to sign up for the picnic online**

### **\*A Paypal account is required\***

The signup for the picnic is the same as used for the day trips this year. However, it's been awhile, so it's likely some have forgotten their passwords or how to use the system.

Before you can start, you must have both a Paypal account (separate action) and register as a member on the Lewis Ski Club page if you have not already received one. This requires joining the club, which is \$10. Recently signed up members can avoid this step as they should have already receive a login. The membership is good until May 2015.

To sign up for the picnic, you need to log in to register and pay for the tickets. To login, select the "LOGIN" link at the upper right corner of the club's web page <https://lewisskiclub.org>. Enter your username and password. As a reminder, your username is LastnameFirstname. To sign up, remember to press "add to cart" on the screen.

If you can not remember your username and password, select the "Request new password" tab. Enter the email address you supplied the club, and a temporary password will be emailed to you.

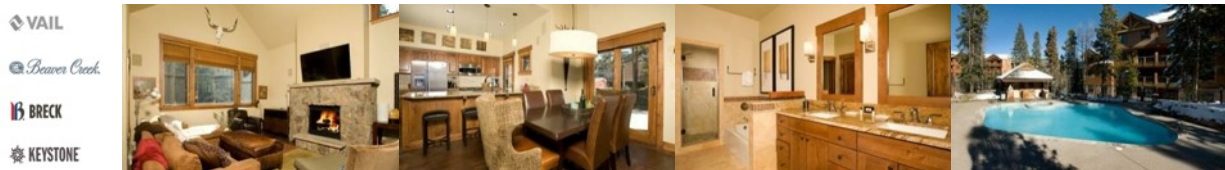
