

## **Proposed Constitution Changes**

The constitution committee has formulated amendments to be voted on at the April General Body Meeting. These proposed changes will be mailed out to the general body before voting takes place at the April Meeting.

The following changes and all new statements are in red

----

**Section 11: Meetings (CHANGE)** 

(FROM) Regular club meetings will take on the first Tuesday of every month with the exception of May and July. Members will be notified of the meeting time and place through the club newsletter.

(TO) Regular club meetings will take on the first Tuesday of every month with the exception of May and July. Members will be notified of the meeting time and place through the official club website and email distribution list.

----

**Section 13: Spending Policy** 

(APPEND) The executive board shall oversee and review the generation of a proposed yearly budget by the September board meeting.

----

**BYLAW #4:** 

(APPEND) All transactions must be conducted directly through the club. For example, it is explicitly against club policy to "transfer your seat" directly to another person.
