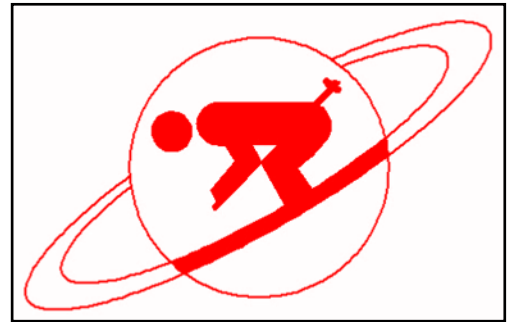

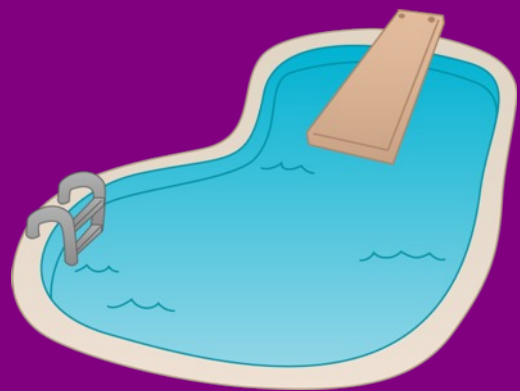
## **Next meeting**

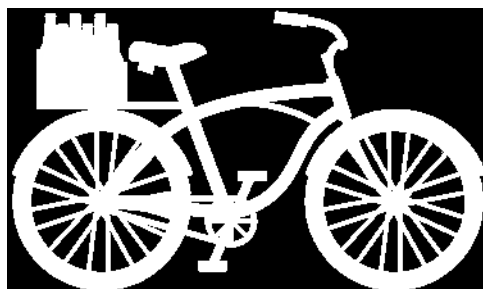
# LEWIS SKI CLUB'S NINTH ANNUAL BIKE/BREW TOUR

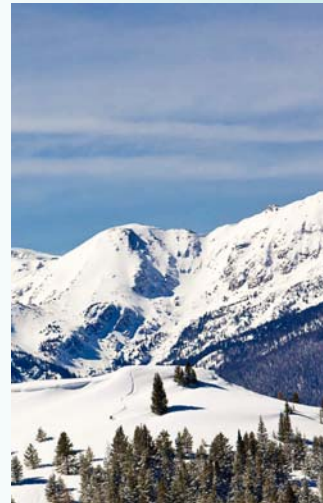
