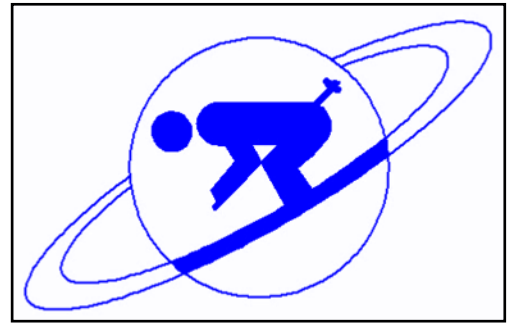

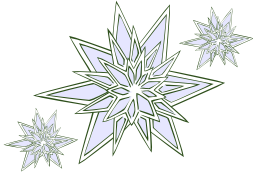
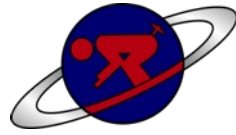
## White Elephant Exchange
