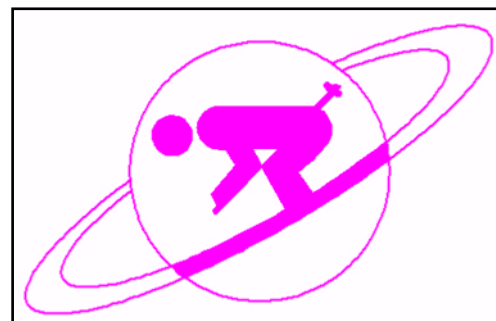

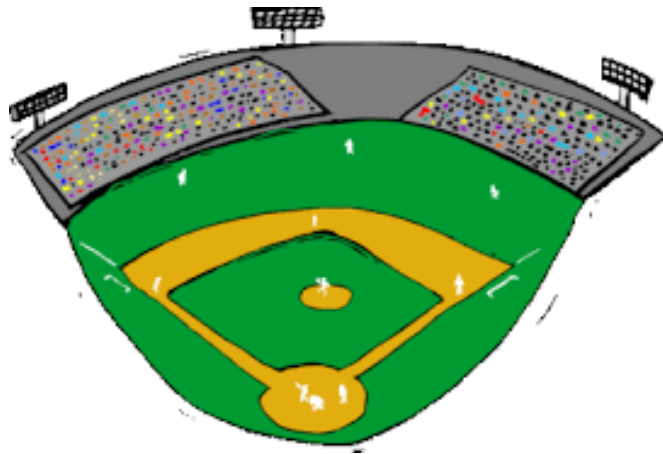
Goodtime outing recap

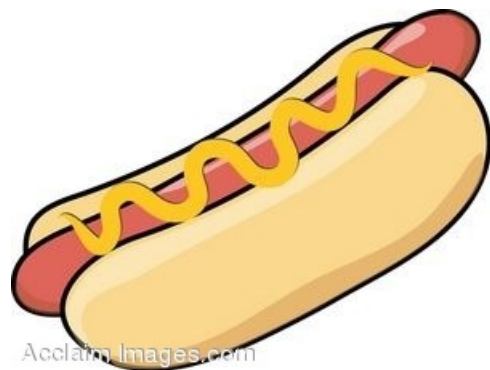
