**Early 'Bluebird' Special Pricing** - The Lewis Ski Club Board of Directors is happy to announce a new discount program for members to save \$10 on each day trip **if registered 30 days prior to the event:**

- \$85 (if purchased 30 days prior)
- \$95 Regular Price

Signing up for all five trips will save you \$50.

Additionally, the board committed to subsidizing all our one-day trips to allow us to charge the lowest possible price. During a recent board meeting we discussed the group rate for Holiday Valley and HoliMont. Unfortunately, HoliMont is charging \$10 more than what Holiday Valley will be charging for the 2021-2022 ski season, so a decision was made to travel exclusively to Holiday Valley Ski Resort. In doing this, for each additional trip we take, Holiday Valley increases the number of complementary lift tickets we receive as a group. We are very hopeful that with the return of our one-day bus trips and this new special pricing, there will be an increase in participation that we had seen wane over the last few years.
