Message From the Alpine VP

There have been epic changes with group skiing as a result of

the EPIC pass. There are many benefits to having a pass: Vail discounts, multiple options for which pass fits your needs, the pass can be loaded to a new app on your phone. One of the drawbacks of Vail resorts now is the expectation that club members purchase their lift tickets on their own. Clubs no longer can purchase a block of lift tickets. This means you will need to purchase a pass on your own to have lift tickets on our extended trips in 2024. There are multiple options available on the website. Ensure your purchase covers our destinations: Heavenly and Beaver Creek. Weigh the costs of buying a few days versus a local pass depending on your planned number of days on the slopes. It is an adjustment for us to think that our trip package will not include lift tickets. I know our trip leaders are almost ready to get things posted.
