EXPLORER GONDOLA – A NEW CHAPTER IN BIG SKY'S LEGACY

Coming winter 2025-26, a new two-stage gondola will replace the existing Explorer chair,

extending all the way to The Bowl. while connecting to the lower terminal of the Lone Peak Tram. The condola will load at the main base near Huntlev Lodge, and transform access to the Explorer northern and Swift Current terrain while providina massive improvements to comfort and speed.



A project two years in the making, the Explorer Gondola is set to transform mountain access for skiers and riders of all abilities.

This world class technology replaces the last original Big Sky lift from 1973 and will revolutionize mountain access, provide seamless connectivity from the main base to beginner terrain via the mid-station and allow guests to travel all the way to the summit of

"The Explorer Gondola represents more than just a new lift—it's set to redefine the mountain experience at Big Sky by connecting guests to the mountain's impressive beginner and advanced terrain". Lone Mountain through the new tram connection at the Gondola upper station.

All 83 gondola cabins will be stored each evening within the 21,000-square-foot mid-station below-grade parking structure.

Renewals can also be purchased at the same low price offered directly through Ikon. (When the ikonpass.com renewal price expires, renewal pricing will still be available through our special link).


Members who register for BigSky and purchase an Ikon pass through our link will have <u>6.5% of the cost of your desired pass deducted from the final balance due for your trip</u>.

- \$ 869 adult Ikon Base Pass cost when purchased <u>using our link</u>
- \$ 909 adult Ikon Base Pass cost when purchased directly from Ikon
- \$859 renewal cost (same for both)
- (Base pass purchases can later be upgraded to an Ikon Pass).



\$1,239 adult Ikon Pass cost when purchased <u>using our link</u>

- \$1,329 adult Ikon Pass cost when purchased directly from Ikon
- \$1,229 renewal cost (same for both)
